

Common Sense 5 - Create Association Beyond Your Circle



In a 100m race, your speed and how well you finish is determined by the way you start. There are starting methods athletes use. There are single start, medium start and elongated start. All these methods are based on having short, medium or long leg. If one has long leg, single start is not favourable, only the elongated is preferable and so on.
